



## REDFYRE CLASSIC HEAT STORAGE COOKER

### YOUR TECHNICAL QUESTIONS ANSWERED

What types of fuel can be used to run the Classic Cooker?

The Classic can run on Natural Gas, LPG or Kerosene (normal domestic fuel oil).

What style of flue can be used with the Classic Cooker?

A conventional flue only.

Does the cooker need to be situated against an external wall?

Not necessarily. This will depend on the intended location and is best discussed with your Redfyre dealer during the site survey.

Will the floor need reinforcing?

As long as the floor is not suspended there should be no reason to reinforce. However, your Redfyre dealer will confirm this when undertaking the site survey.

Can the Classic Cooker supply domestic hot water?

Yes, as an option on all models.

Is the Classic Cooker designed for intermittent use?

Yes. The Classic can be run constantly but is also designed for a more flexible, modern lifestyle. It can, therefore, be adjusted manually with approximate warm up times from low of just 55 minutes for the ovens and 15 minutes for the hobs (oil), or 60 minutes and 40 minutes respectively from cold (gas). This is much quicker than other conventional heat store cookers.

Can the Classic be programmed to provide specific heating periods?

Yes. The electronic programmer option allows you to plan regular morning, lunchtime and evening sessions or even to cook while you are out.

How often should my Classic be serviced?

The gas version should be serviced annually whilst the oil version should be every Six months.

*N.B. Please ask your retailer to survey your kitchen. It will help ensure you enjoy the best possible performance from your range cooker.*
